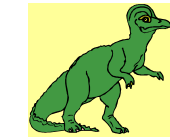
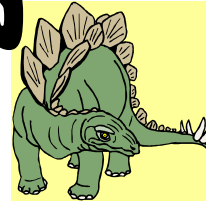


Topic fun
