Maths corner

This week we have been making arrays. Arrays are an arrangement of objects into a grid with the same number in each row and column. They show multiplication as repeated addition and children can see that you can switch the numbers in a multiplication number sentence.


$$5 \times 2 = 10$$

$$2 \times 5 = 10$$

$$2 + 2 + 2 + 2$$

$$+ 2 = 10$$

$$5 + 5 = 10$$



See if you can choose 2 numbers to 10 and make an array. Can you write it as a number sentence? You could even start learning your 2, 5 and 10 times tables by heart!
