Maths

This week we have been using small and large bricks, counters and fingers to add two amounts together. We have used the words, add, plus, altogether. We have also written addition number sentences in our lovely new Maths books while wearing our superhero capes! We have been working hard to remember that every number begins at the top!

Next week we will use practical equipment such as unifix bricks to work out the bonds to 5 and 10 eg $0+5=5$, $1+4=5$, $2+3=5$ etc. We will see if the children spot any patterns.
