

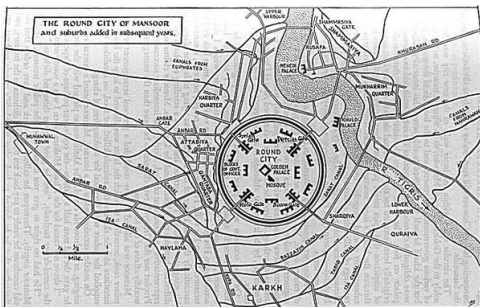
Just to let you know
