Telling The Time

We are learning to tell the time for o'clock, quarter past, half past and quarter to for any hour.

Please help your child to read the time analogue and at home. Can your child learn some of the times that things happen during the day. e.g. wake up, leave for school, eat dinner, go to bed, etc.

Practise finding out how many minutes every day tasks take and learn how many minutes make an hour, and hours make a day.

Maths Corner

We have been practicing partitioning numbers into different combinations of tens and units.

E.g. $43 = 40 + 3$

$43 = 30 + 14$ $43 = 20 + 23$ etc.

We also had fun estimating and measuring in the Wild Place. The children are getting good at this! Try measuring using centimetres and metres. Can you work out the difference between two lengths in cm? e.g. If my foot is 20cm and your foot is 15cm, how much longer is my foot?
