We have been dividing this week! We learnt about grouping and sharing. For example, grouping would be:

I have 12 wheels. Group into 4's to see how many cars I could make.

Sharing would be:

I have 12 sweets and 3 people. How many do they get each?

Can you choose a number and see how many ways you can divide it? For example, does 15 divide into 4 equal groups? How might you record your findings?
