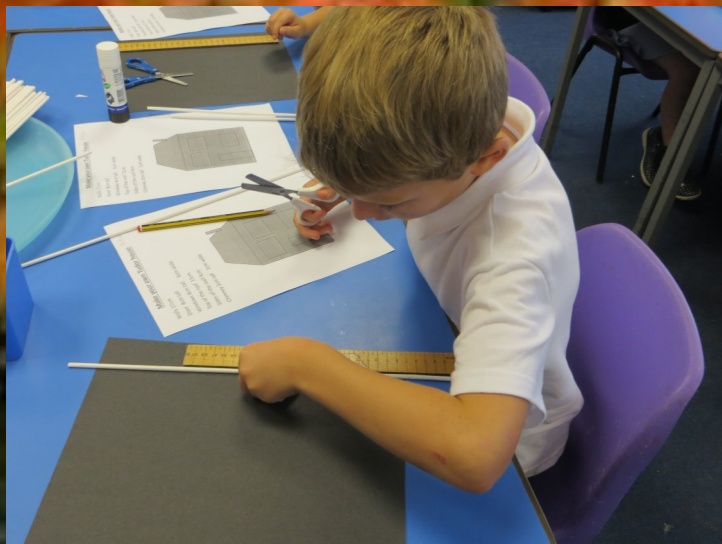

## This week...

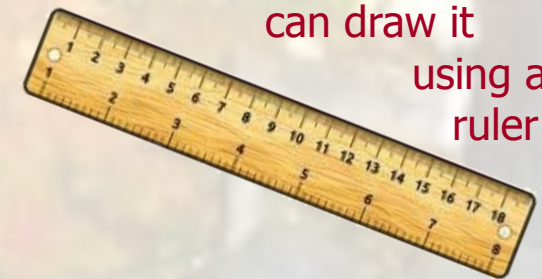
