## Curriculum

**English:** Some children have now written their scenes and are rehearsing using their own stage directions—we may be ready show an extract of this during the Open afternoon! **Maths:** Our Victory Garden designs are almost complete with some children investigating area and perimeter of irregular shaped gardens and areas of planting. The children have been investigating number puzzles using quick recall of number facts, reasoning and logic. Work on coordinates continues to expand their knowledge of countries involved in WW2 .
