

Just to let you know...

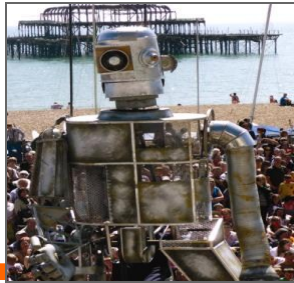
This week's spellings:
