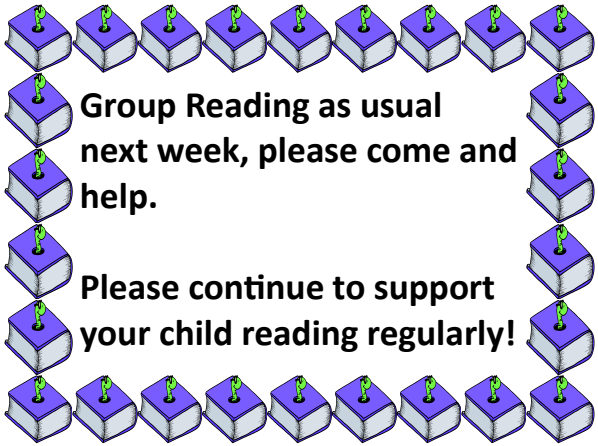

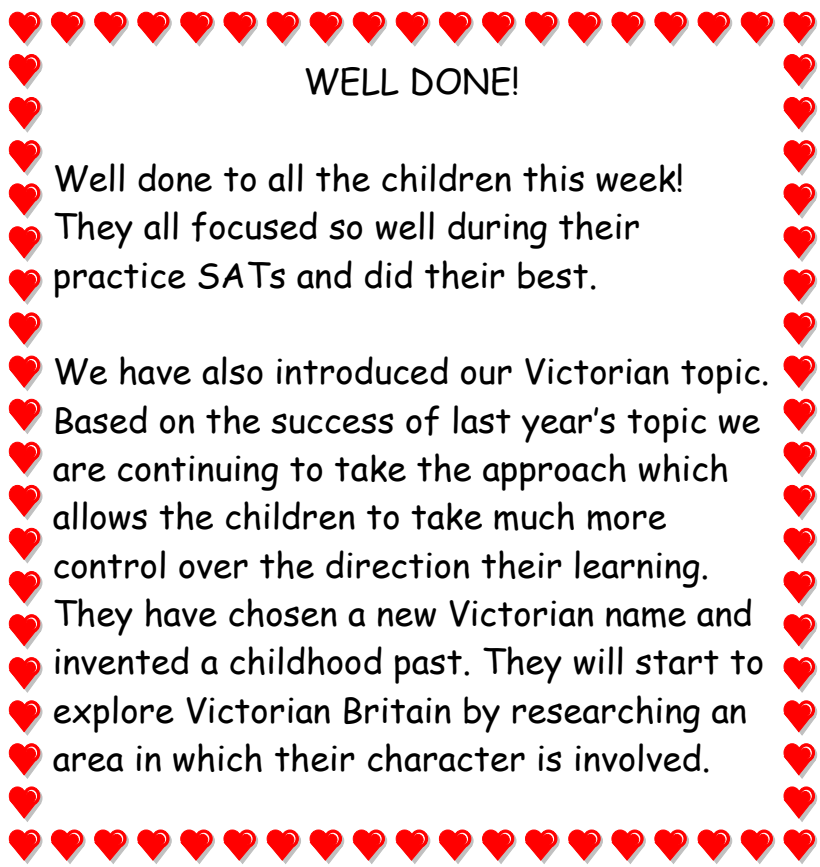


Group Reading as usual next week, please come and help.

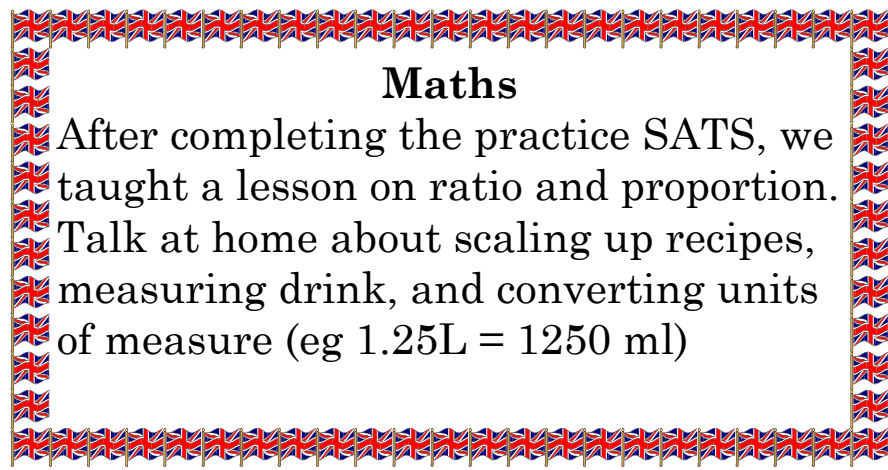


Dear Parents,
