

Maths Focus

This week we have introduced arrays. An array is a group of objects organised into rows and columns to make it easier to count them, for instance in multiples. For example: This array is 2 lots of 5, or 5 lots of 2.

● ● ● ● ● We can count them in 2s or 5s to find out how many there are, "2, 4, 6, 8, 10", "5, 10". Some of the children have been learning that this can be written as 2×5 or 5×2 .

Can you roll 2 dice and draw an array of those 2 numbers, telling your grown-up what you have made. E.g. "I have got 3 lots of 5, or 5 lots of 3."
