The menus that have been finished are looking superb! Remember these should all be handed in before half term.

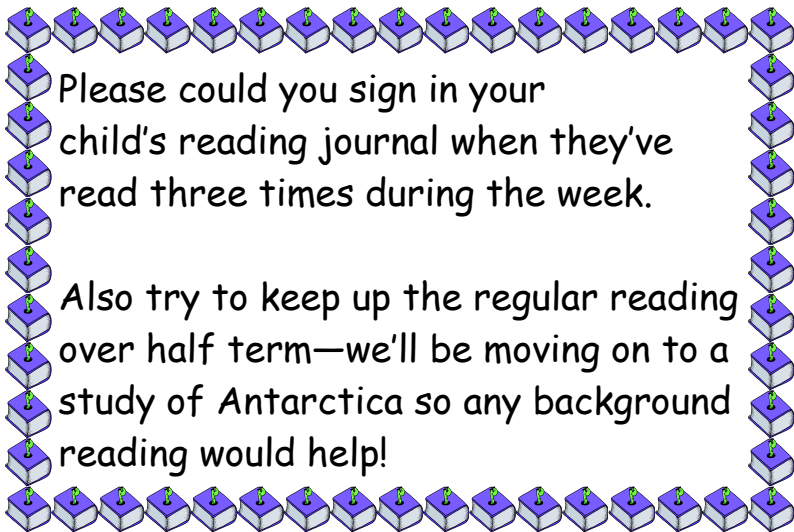
Any unfinished topic work will be sent home to finish.

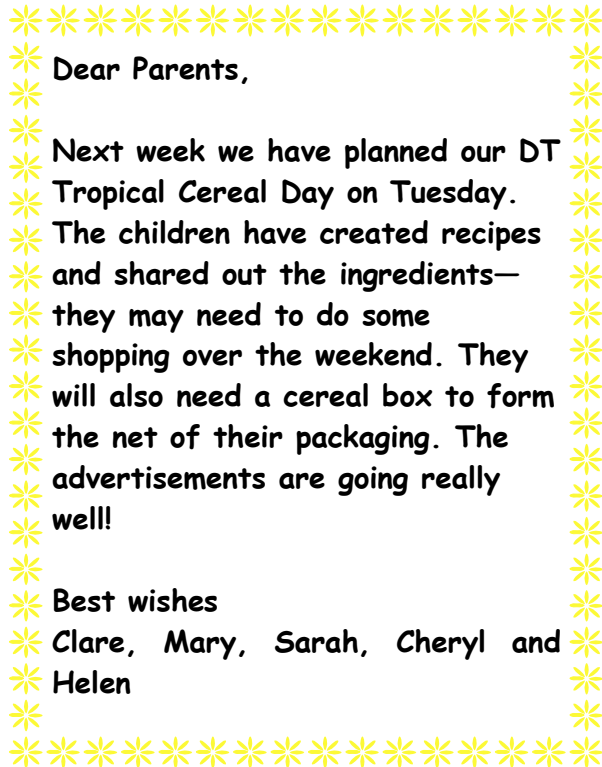

Also try to keep up the regular reading over half term—we'll be moving on to a study of Antarctica so any background reading would help!

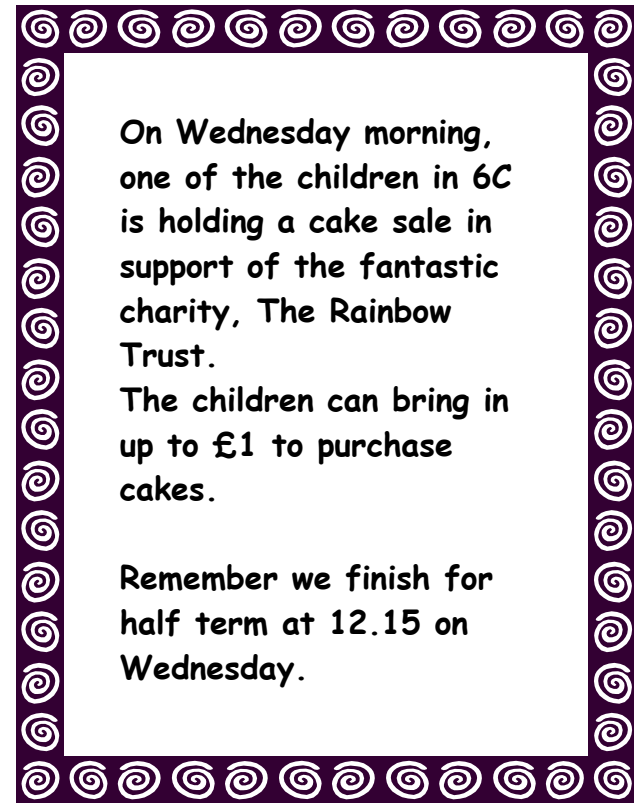


Dear Parents,

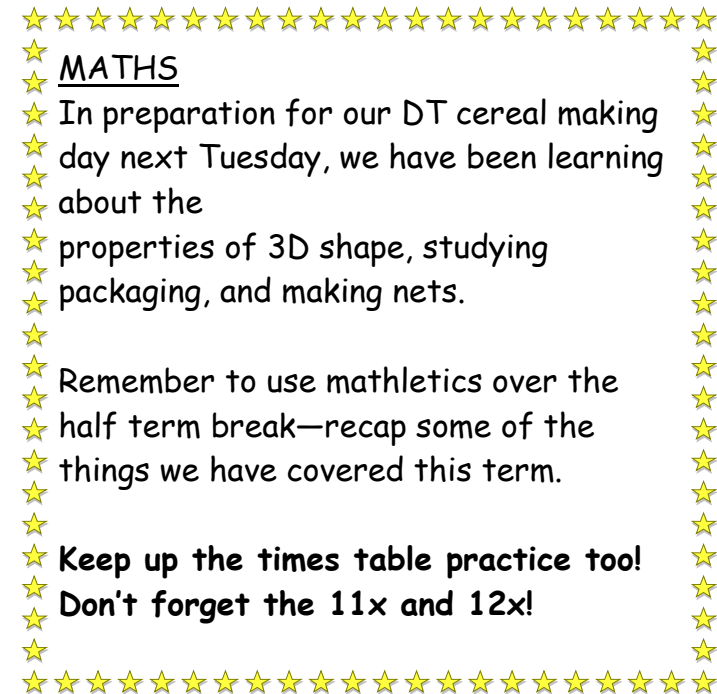
