

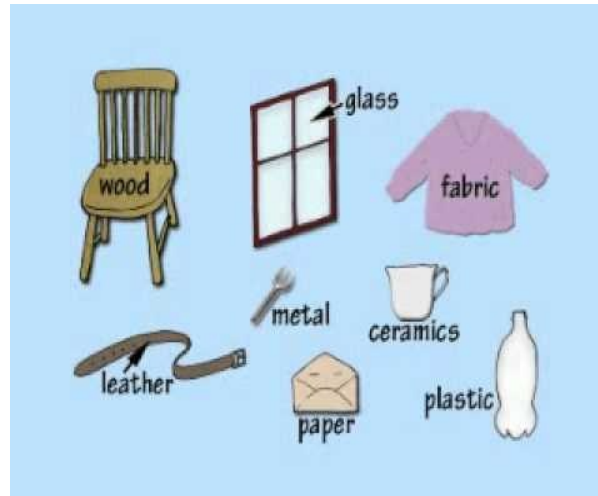
Just to let you know...

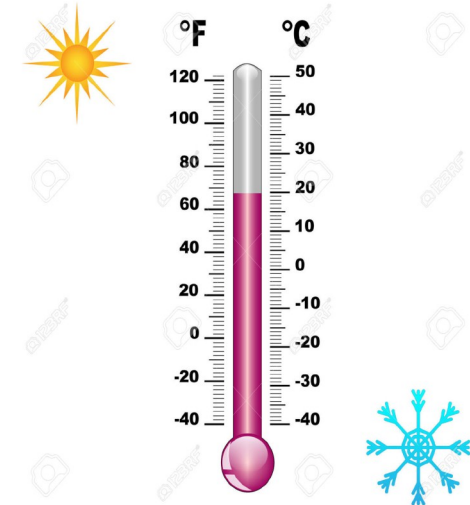
English
