English:

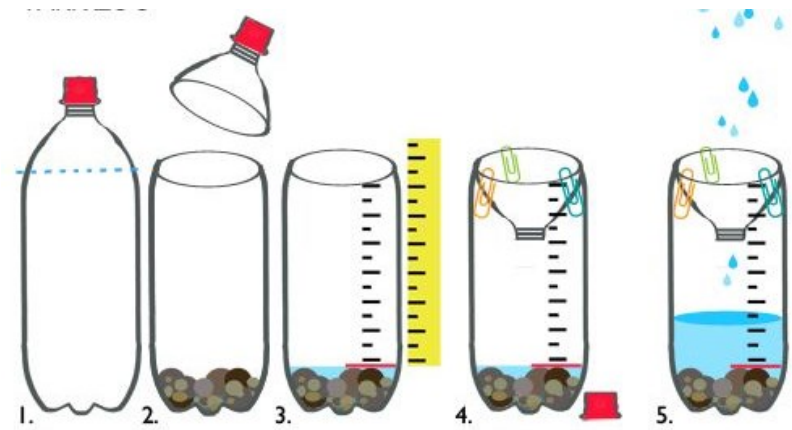

Maths:

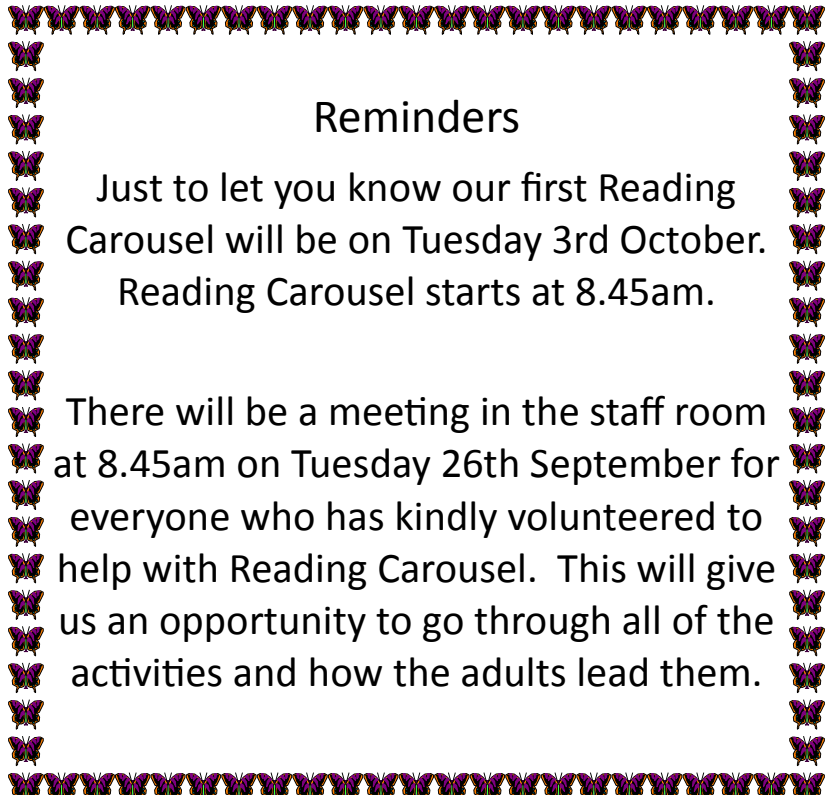

Topic:

We learnt about the water cycle and where the water in our tap comes from. We learnt how to draw an axis and label them correctly and are really excited about recording the daily rainfall on our graphs.
