Learning letter names in order.

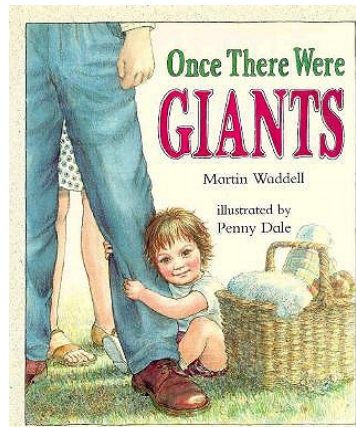
