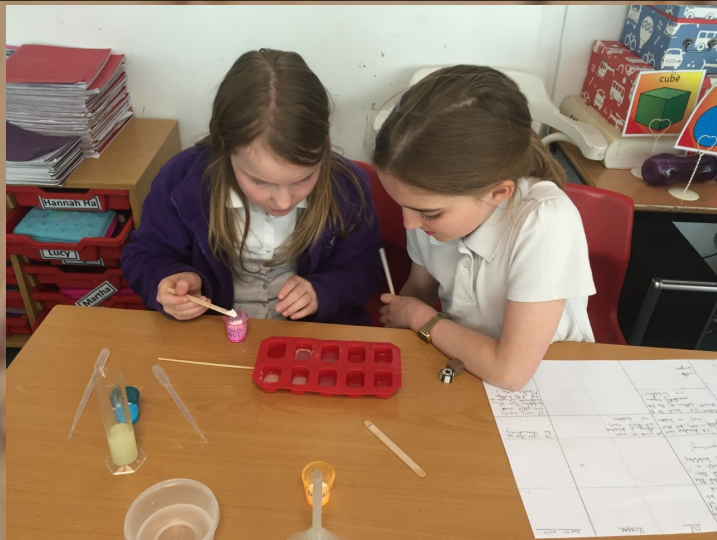


# Just to let you know...

## Maths

The children started the week applying their knowledge of length to a whole variety of word problems and converting between different units of length. On Thursday, the children began looking at capacity. We estimated the capacity of a range of containers, filled them with water and accurately measured their capacity. We found that in most cases we underestimated the amount in the containers.



## Homework

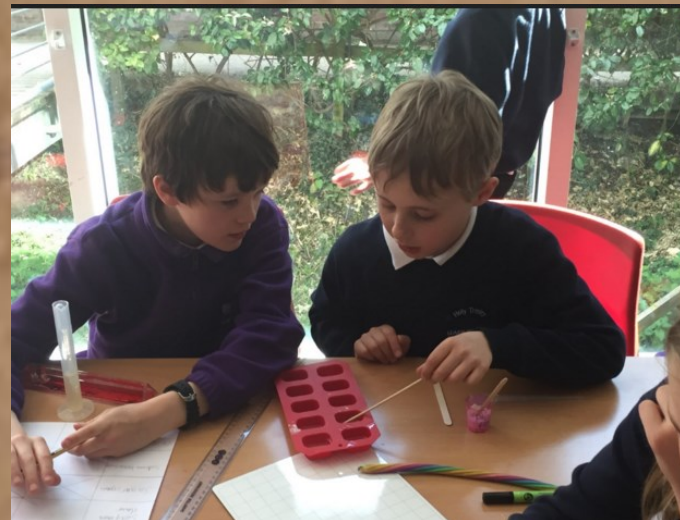
We would like the children to measure the length and width of their bedrooms and record this in centimetres, millimetres and metres. If they have time they could go on to measure the perimeter of some of their furniture and record this too.

## Literacy

Continuing our focus on poetry we have been looking at the journey of a river. The children have read a variety of poetry and are now embarking on their own poem encompassing the journey from source to mouth. They are using a range of adverbs, high quality vocabulary and personification.
