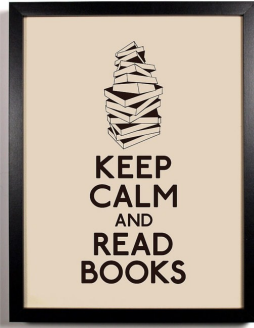


In maths this week we have been taking some mock SATS tests to begin to get the children ready for later in the year.
