We have been learning to divide by 'sharing fairly' this week. We have looked at numbers up to 30 which can be shared equally e.g. $4 \div 2 = 2$, and numbers where a 'remainder' is left over e.g. "7 biscuits shared between 3 children is 2 each and one left over."
