Sound of the Week

We have been making silly sentences with 'air' words; chair, stair, fairy, hair etc. We really can see the difference in the children's work when they have been practising their sounds at home. Maths Focus

We have been continuing to think about place value this week. We have been ordering non-sequential numbers to 100 by looking at the tens and then the units to order the numbers. Some of us also had a go at adding two digit numbers together by adding the units then the tens.

Next week we will be learning about time. We will be ordering days of the week and months of the year, reading o'clock and half past, as well as solving problems related to time. E.g. If the pig builds the house at 3 o'clock and the wolf blows it down at 6 o'clock, how many hours did the house stay up?

We've been having a big push on number writing and getting numbers the right way round. See how many numbers you can write correctly in 1 minute!
