IRON MAN:


Please send in any unwanted metal objects that we can use to make our very own Iron Men. This will support our work on metals, magnetism and electricity.

This week the children have begun to study 2D shapes, looking at a range of different properties; sides, angles, parallel sides, regular/irregular.
