



Maths

We will be focusing on adding number this week. We will be making 2 groups of objects and counting how many we have altogether. The teachers will be modelling how number sentences are written. The children will be encouraged to explain their calculations to 10/20 using language such as add, and, altogether, more, makes and equals. E.g. 10 bears and/add 3 bears make 13 bears.
