Maths Focus

This week we have been practising our number bonds and finding out how many different ways to make 10. We used addition and then some of us tried using taking away to make 10.

Do you know which of these number sentences make 10?

$$4 + 6 = \quad 6 + 4 = \quad 2 + 8 = \quad 2 + 5 = \quad 1 + 9 = \quad 7 + 3 =$$

Ask your child to practise number bonds by telling them a number between 0 and 10 and they have to say the number that makes 10 (eg you say 7, they say 3!) . Once you are really fast at this can you find pairs of number that make 20 together?
