

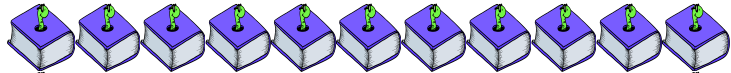
As an introduction to our Great Expedition the children have applied to be accepted by the Royal Geographical Society.
