

Maths

This week the children have been measuring weight and capacity.

We have learned what we would weigh in grams and kilograms. The children have practised reading and labelling scales in different intervals.

We have also had lots of hands on experience of estimating and counting in 10ml with litre jugs as well as non-standard measures such as egg cups and spoons.

Have a go at estimating how many litre jugs you would need to fill your bath at bath time. Then estimate and find out how heavy your teddy weighs - will you weigh him in grams or kg? Can you find out how many litres of water it takes to fill a swimming pool? Which is heavier - your teddy or your school shoes?
