Maths

All the children have been working so hard on using formal written methods of addition. They have previously built up a super understanding by using number lines and partitioning and now are able to work on multi-step word problems using column addition.

Writing:

This week the children really enjoyed working on direct speech. They started off by using comic strips and speech bubbles and then moved on to using speech marks in dialogue. We had a real focus on using a wide range of punctuation in the conversations.

Science:
