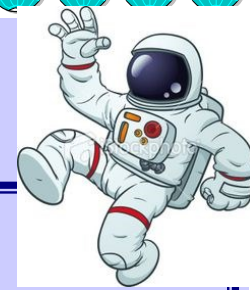
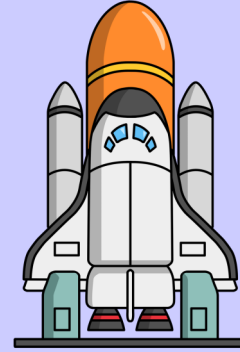


## English and Topic
