What would happen if we bought 8 products or how many would we have paid for to get 4 free? Ask questions that allow them to understand the practical application of ratio.

Here is a recipe for 9 large cupcakes:

110g/4oz butter or margarine,
softened at room temperature

110g/4oz caster sugar

2 free-range eggs, lightly beaten

1 tsp vanilla extract

110g/4oz self-raising flour

1-2 tbsp milk

What would they need for 3 cupcakes,
18 cupcakes, 45 cupcakes etc?
