Thank you for coming along to Parent Consultations this week, we have really enjoyed talking about your children with you. We hope you found the session helpful and do remember that you can always contact us by email or request a meeting if there is anything you want to discuss.

Some simple tips to support your child's learning at home:

Count up to 20 out loud. Count up to 20 objects by laying them out neatly and pointing to each one .

Read regularly with your child. Make up and say a simple sentence together, counting the number of words that you are using.
