Pretzel Butterflies



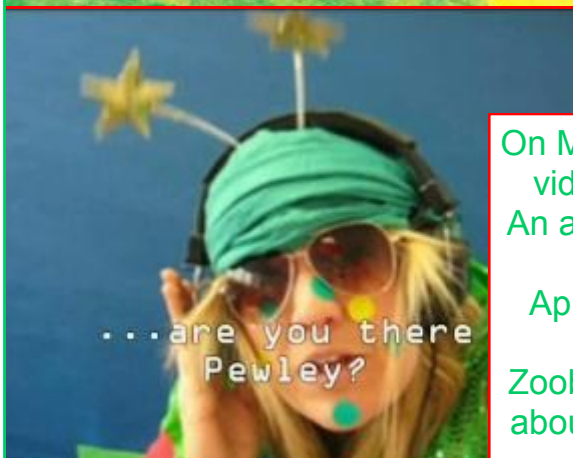
Phonics
