Please don't forget to read with your child. It would be great if you could read newspapers or current affairs magazines too, particularly with the referendum about Europe pending.

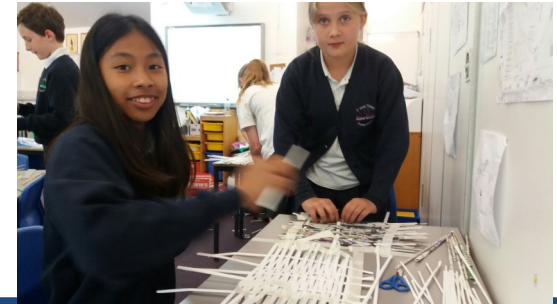
Maths
