Maths

We have been revisiting multiplication, division and fraction this week. We have been impressed by how well the children have remembered their learning. They have been so excited to show us their times tables knowledge, too. Some children have even been making links between division and fraction now they feel more confident with it which is great to see.

English

We have been having a great time writing an adapted version of an episode of 'Andy's Dinosaur Adventures'. We have tried to focus on using adjectives and joining words such as 'because' 'so' 'when' and 'but'. Some children are beginning to use contracted forms e.g. can't, don't, didn't. We have certainly needed to use some exclamation marks too, but we have been careful not to overuse them.

Topic
