Next week, the children will also be set the task of designing and making their own siege weapon. What information can you find out about Roman siege weapons to share with the class?

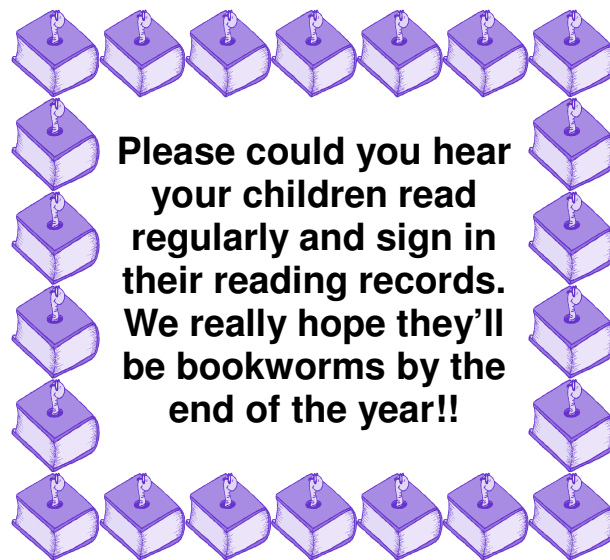
Just to let you know...
