



Curriculum News:



English:

We have looked closely at the key features of a non-fiction text. The children have been able to identify contents, index, glossary, captions and subheadings. They have used this knowledge to research an animal of their choosing.



Maths:

The children have continued to build on their knowledge of number looking at inverse facts, subtraction using a number line and identifying the correct operation to use for a worded problem.



Topic:

This week we have been finding out about the 5 main animal groups used for classification. The children also finished their rain gauges and have prepared their data collection sheet; we are just waiting for some rain!
