

**Curriculum News:**

**English:**

This week we have been having fun with alliteration. The children have thought of funny names for themselves. We had some really funny ones including Zippy Zak, Naughty Nick and Hilarious Hannah. The children used their understanding of alliteration to write headlines for the Noah story.

**Maths:**

We have continued our work on place value. We believe that this is the foundation on which all our number work rests. We have looked at place value up to tens of thousands and have been ordering and comparing numbers. We have made great use of dice, to generate and work with different digits.

**Topic:**

In science we have been exploring different materials and predicting whether they will float or sink. We started our art carousel this week looking at clay modelling, batik and hand puppets.
