English:

This week we have continued to work on constructing sentences and the different word types. Can your child tell you about proper nouns and verbs? Later in the week we turned our focus to poetry by writing our own poems about our favourite animals.

Maths:

The children have been consolidating their knowledge of place value and learning to order numbers. They have used Diennes and arrow cards to identify the value of a single digit in a 2 and 3 digit number.

Topic:

In Science we have discussed our thoughts and ideas about why some objects float and others sink. We made predictions which we then tested, discussing what we had learnt.

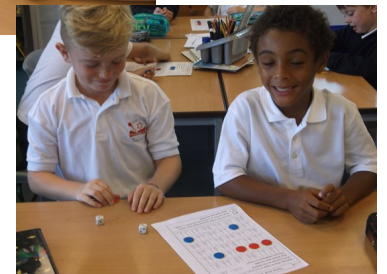
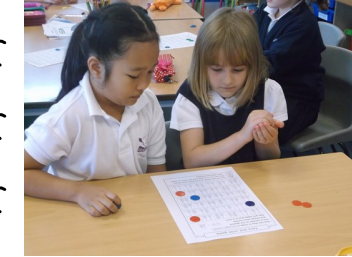
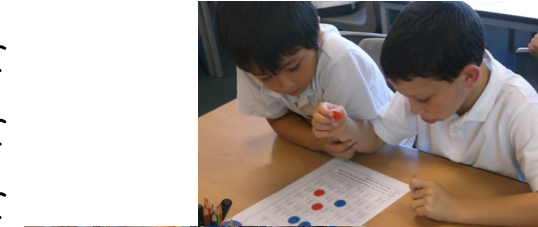


Spellings: hope, take, make, safe, like, ride, smile, game
