Layers of the Rainforest

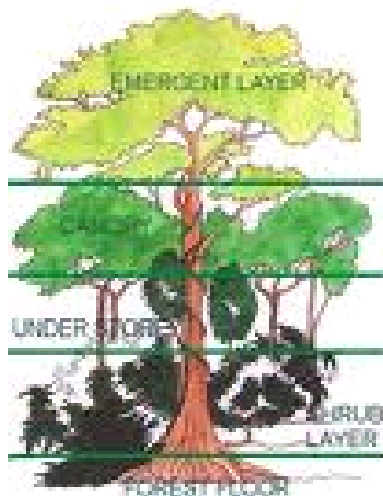
