

Maths Focus

This week we have been exploding numbers into 10s and units. For instance, 14 exploded into 10 and 4. We learnt that 14 is made up of 1 ten and 4 units. We used arrow cards to build 2 digit numbers and used tens and units blocks to represent numbers. We used our knowledge of tens and units to order numbers to 100.

Can you explode some numbers to 100 into tens and units? Can you choose 5 numbers from 0-100 and order them from smallest to biggest? Can you add two 2 digit numbers together?
