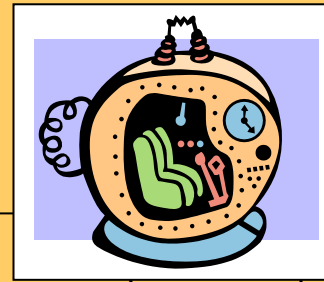


Topic
