After half term we'll be writing adventure stories so it's well worth your child reading some adventures or watching adventure films to get a sense of the features, e.g. a quest, a dilemma, a solution.

The punctuation focus will be apostrophes for possession, e.g. The cat's whiskers/The cats' whiskers.

Spellings will be speech words that the children might like to use in their story writing:

said, asked, replied, answered, shouted, sobbed, whispered, squealed, screamed, muttered
