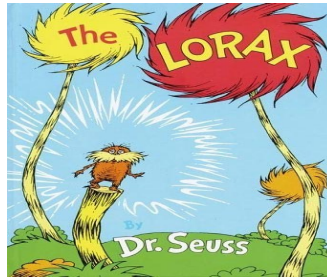

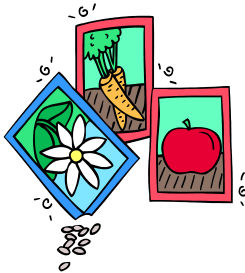
The Once-ler
