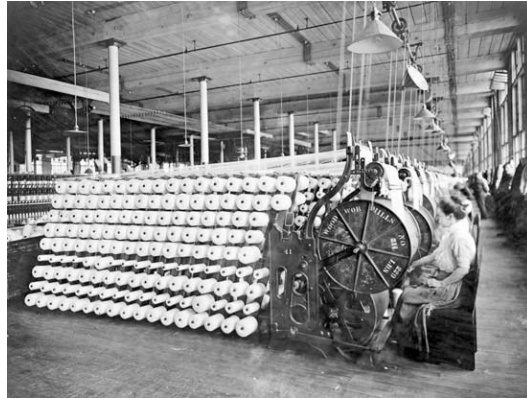
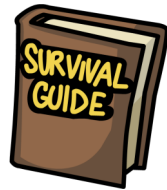


# Just to let you know..
