Thank you for your support this term, we hope you have an enjoyable and relaxing Easter break!

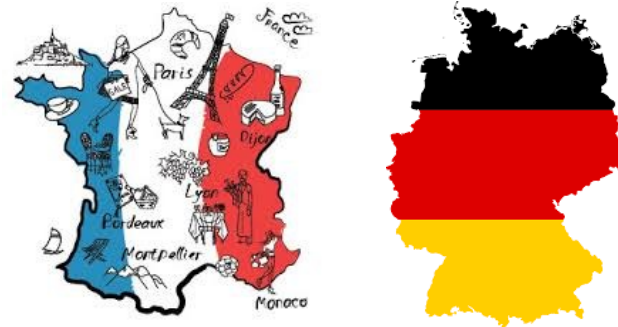
